India to have 35 multimodal logistics parks under Bharatmala project: Gadkari



Indo-China trade likely to cross \$100 bn this year

BEIJING, Oct. 25

AS the Indo-China trade total has already touched \$90 billion in the first nine months, despite a chill in bilateral relations due to the continuing military standoff in eastern Ladakh, India-China trade volume looks set to cross the record figure of \$100 billion this year. China's total imports and exports expanded 22.7 per cent yearon-year to 28.33 trillion yuan (about \$4.38 trillion) in the first three quarters of 2021, official data showed. The figure marked an increase of 23.4 per cent from the prepandemic level in 2019, according to its General Administration of Customs. Bilateral trade between India and China totalled \$90.37 billion by the end of September, an increase of 49.3 per cent year-on-year, according to the nine-month data released by the Chinese Customs, as per a report.
